Symbol is הכ"ז: *Rosh HaShanah* falls out on Thursday (the fifth day of the week; *Cheshvan* is 29 days and *Kislev* is 30 days (*Cheshvan* is 29 days and *Kislev* is 30 days); *Pesach* falls out on *Shabbos* (the seventh day of the week). The year is a regular year consisting of 354 days and containing 51 *Shabosos*. It is the 18th year of the 304th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 7th year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the year of *Shemitah* according to the computation of the *Gaonim* and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 13 *Tishrei,* Oct. 7 at 3:00 P.M.

Tekufas Teves: 16 *Teves,* Jan. 6, at 10:30 P.M.

Tekufas Nisan: 19 *Nisan,* Apr. 8 at 6:00 A.M..

Tekufas Tamuz: 21 *Tamuz,* July 8, at 1:30 P.M.
