THE ARRANGEMENT OF THE YEAR

5769 from the creation of the world. Symbol is גכ"ה: *Rosh HaShanah* falls out on *Tuesday* (the third day of the week;) *Cheshvan* is 29 days and *Kislev* 30 days (כסדרן) - *Pesach* falls out on *Thursday* (the fifth day of the week). The year is a regular year consisting of 354 days and containing 50 *Shabosos*. It is the 12th year of the 304th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 1st year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the First year of the *Shemittah* cycle (seven years) according to the computation of the *Gaonim* and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies that are result of the earth's revolution around the sun are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 8 *Tishrei* (Tuesday, Oct. 7) at 3:00 AM.

Tekufas Teves: 10 *Teves* (Tuesday, Jan. 6) at 10:30 AM.

Tekufas Nisan: 14 *Nisan* (Tuesday night April 7) at 6:00 PM.

Tekufas Tamuz: 16 *Tamuz* (Wednesday, July 8) at 1:30 AM.
