Symbol is הכ"ז : Rosh HaShanah falls out on Thursday (the fifth day of the week; Cheshvan is 29 days and Kislev is 30 days (בסדרוכ); Pesach falls out on Shabbos (the seventh day of the week). The year is a regular year consisting of 354 days and containing 51 Shabosos. It is the 2nd year of the 305th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 10th year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the 3rd year of the Shemitah cycle (seven years) according to the computation of the Gaonim and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 17 *Tishrei,* Oct. 7 at 9:00 A.M.

Tekufas Teves: 19 *Teves*, Jan. 6, at 4:30 P.M.

Tekufas Nisan: 23 Nisan, Apr. 7, at 12:00 A.M.

Tekufas Tamuz: 25 Tamuz, July 8, at 7:30 A.M.
