Symbol is בש"ז: Rosh HaShanah falls out on Monday (the second day of the week; Cheshvan and Kislev are both 30 days (שלמים); Pesach falls out on Saturday (the seventh day of the week). The year is a Leap year consisting of 385 days and containing 55 Shabosos. It is the 3rd year of the 305th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 11th year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the Fourth year of the Shemitah cycle (seven years) according to the computation of the Gaonim and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 28 *Tishrei,* Oct. 7 at 3:00 P.M.

Tekufas Teves: 1 *Shevat*, Jan. 6, at 10:30 P.M.

Tekufas Nisan: 3 Nissan, Apr. 8 at 6:00 A.M.

Tekufas Tamuz: 5 *Tamuz*, July 8, at 1:30 P.M.
